



Invitation To: Children's Uniform Clinical Network Provider Trainings

UnitedHealthcare invites you to participate in State-required online standardized evidence-based behavioral health training available through Center for Practice Innovations (CPI) for the following providers: Outpatient child serving clinics, Children and Family Treatment and Support Services (CFTSS), Children's Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS).

As of June 1, 2020, **five (5) core** trainings became available for children's behavioral health clinical staff free of charge. Providers will be able to generate summary reports of completed trainings to support internal continuous quality improvement activities. In addition, CEU's and CASAC credits are available for completing trainings below:

- Family-Driven and Youth Guided Practice
- Recovery and Resilience for Children and Youth
- Understanding Family Engagement and Best Practices
- Coordination/collaboration Across Child Serving Systems
- Trauma Informed Care in the Child/Adolescent Behavioral Healthcare System

Enrollment and registration information:

- Program supervisors will be invited to complete a brief 5-item enrollment survey. This survey link is posted on the CPI website here.
- Once a program supervisor enrolls their program, CPI will send this supervisor a "self-registration link" that is unique for that program.
- The program supervisor will forward this link to providers who need to register for the training.
- The provider clicks the link to create a username and password and, once approved, receives an email with detailed instructions for accessing the training.

If staff at a program already have an account in the CPI LMS, they should contact the CPI help desk at cpihelp@nyspi.columbia.edu so that their accounts can be correctly designated with the addition of the Children's Uniform Clinical Network Provider Training. This step is **very important** otherwise completion won't be reflected in our reporting for this training.
