21st Century Cures Act Requirements: Medicaid Registration Required

Starting Dec. 15, 2018, UnitedHealth Community Plan Wisconsin will begin enforcing the 21st Century Cures Act requirements. Under the 21st Century Cures Act requirements, State Medicaid agencies must screen and enroll all Medicaid managed care providers (42 CFR Part 455 subpart E).

What This Means for You

All care providers treating UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of Wisconsin members must be **registered with Medicaid**. If you are already enrolled with Medicaid, please check that your demographic information is current with the state before performing services for Medicaid and UnitedHealthcare Dual Special Needs Plan members.

If you are not registered with Medicaid, we may deny your claims. Claims for emergency care are the only exception to this requirement.

How to Enroll with Medicaid

If you are not already registered with Wisconsin Medicaid, you can enroll by visiting **forwardhealth.wi.gov** > Become a Provider > Start or Continue Your Enrollment.
